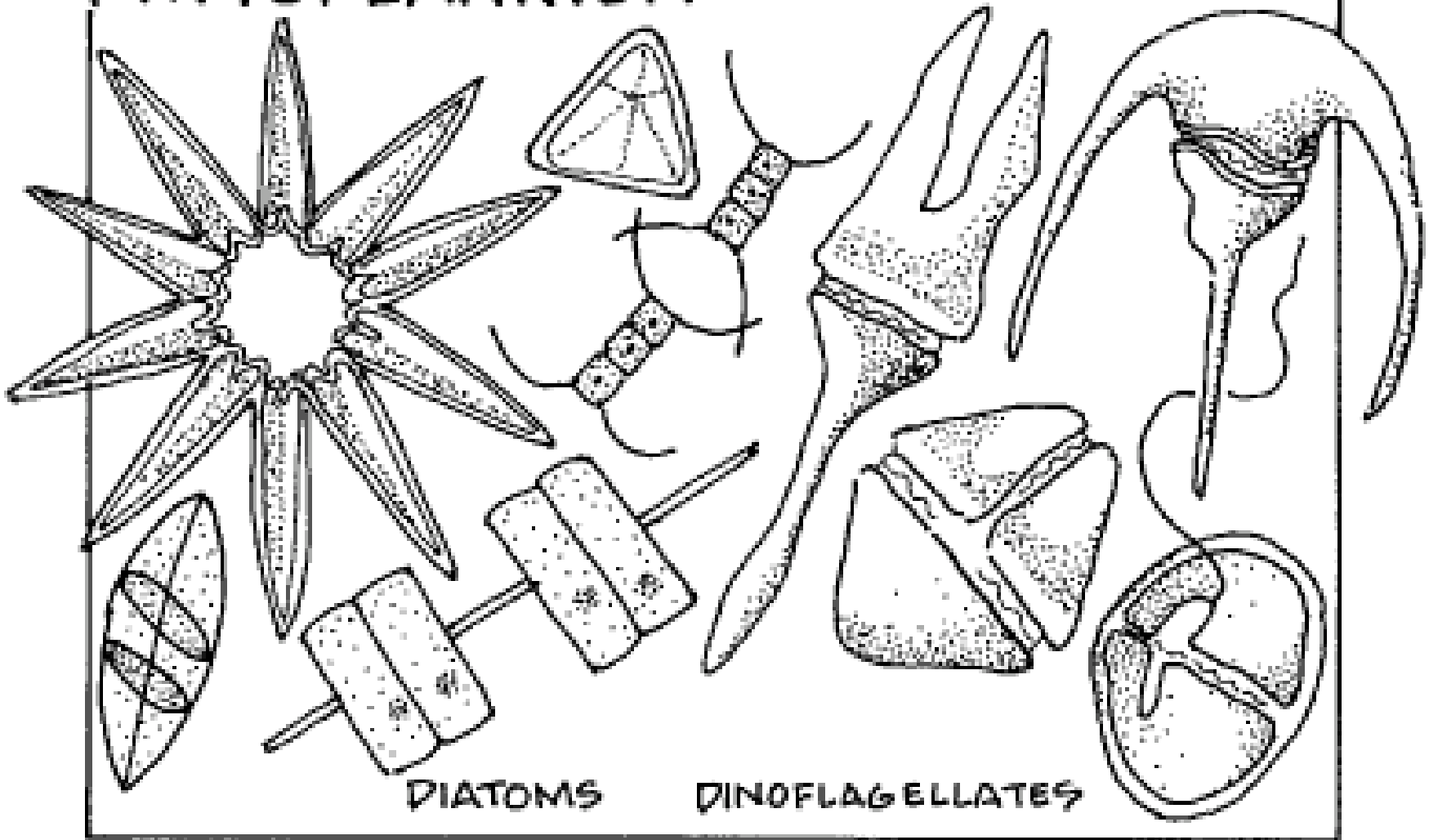

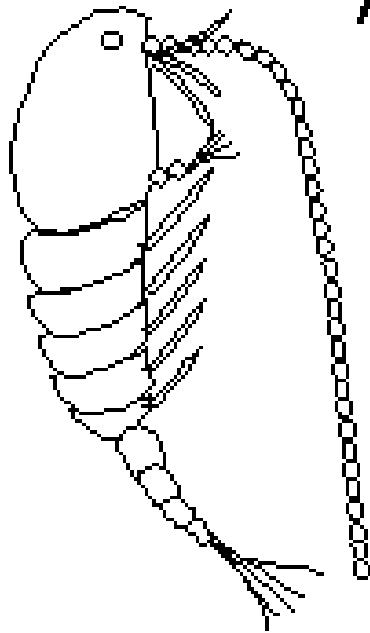

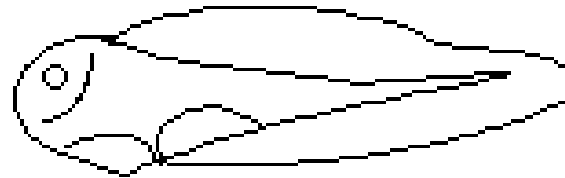

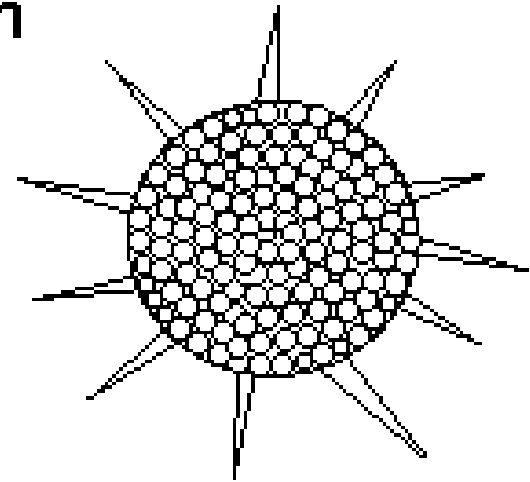

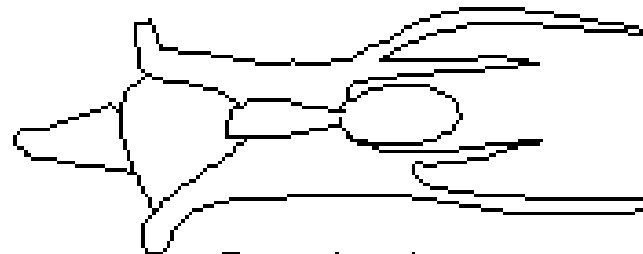

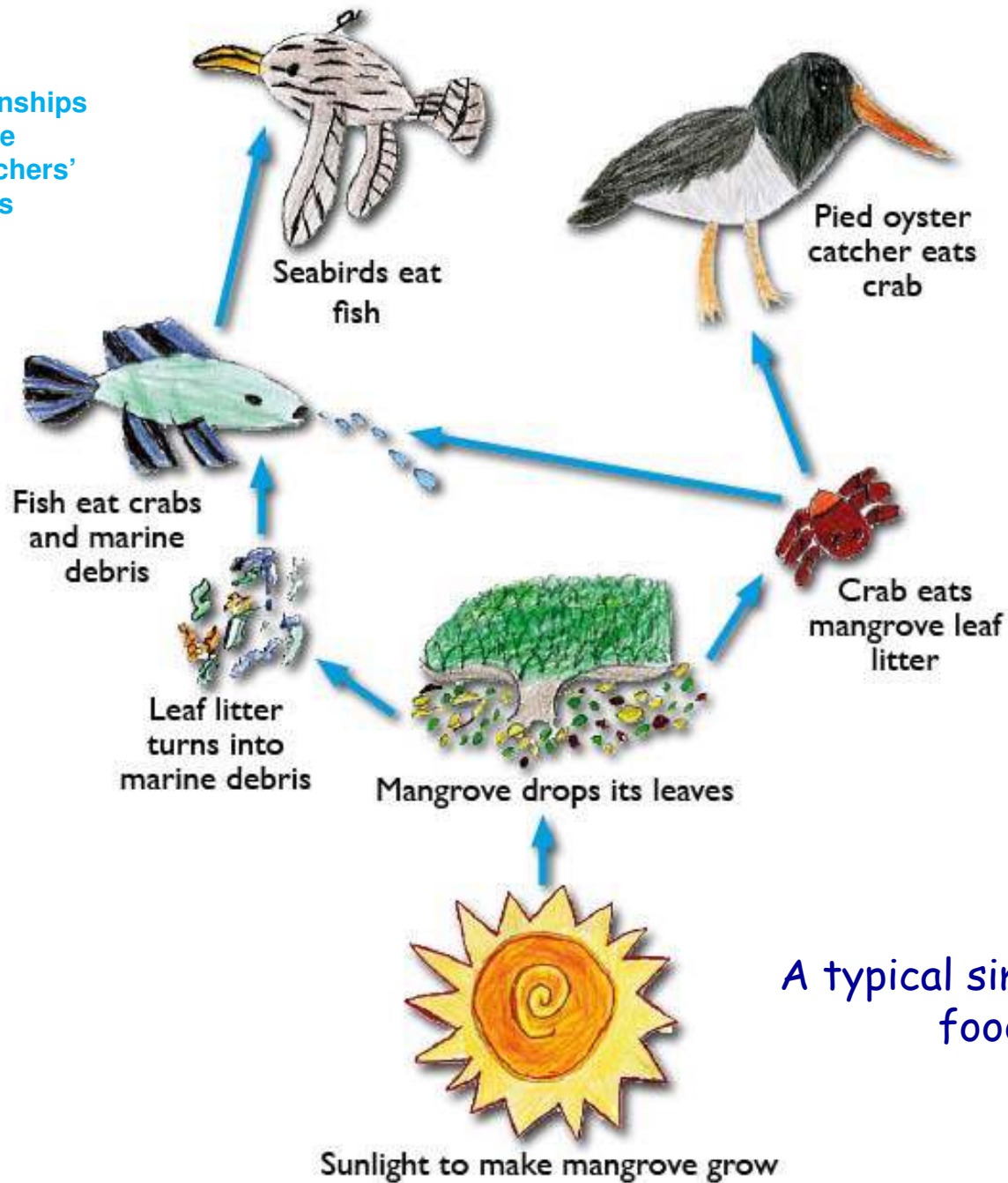

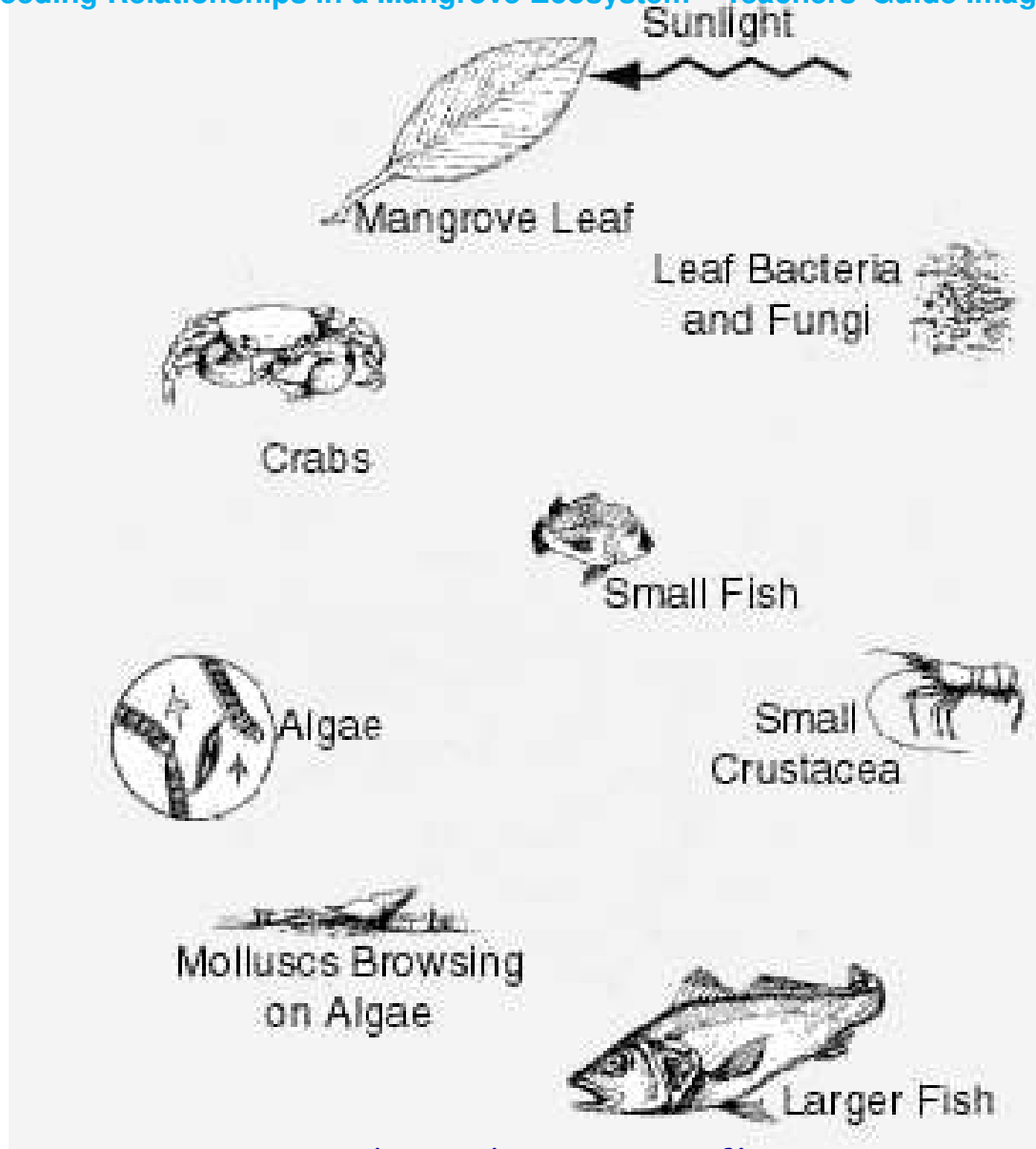

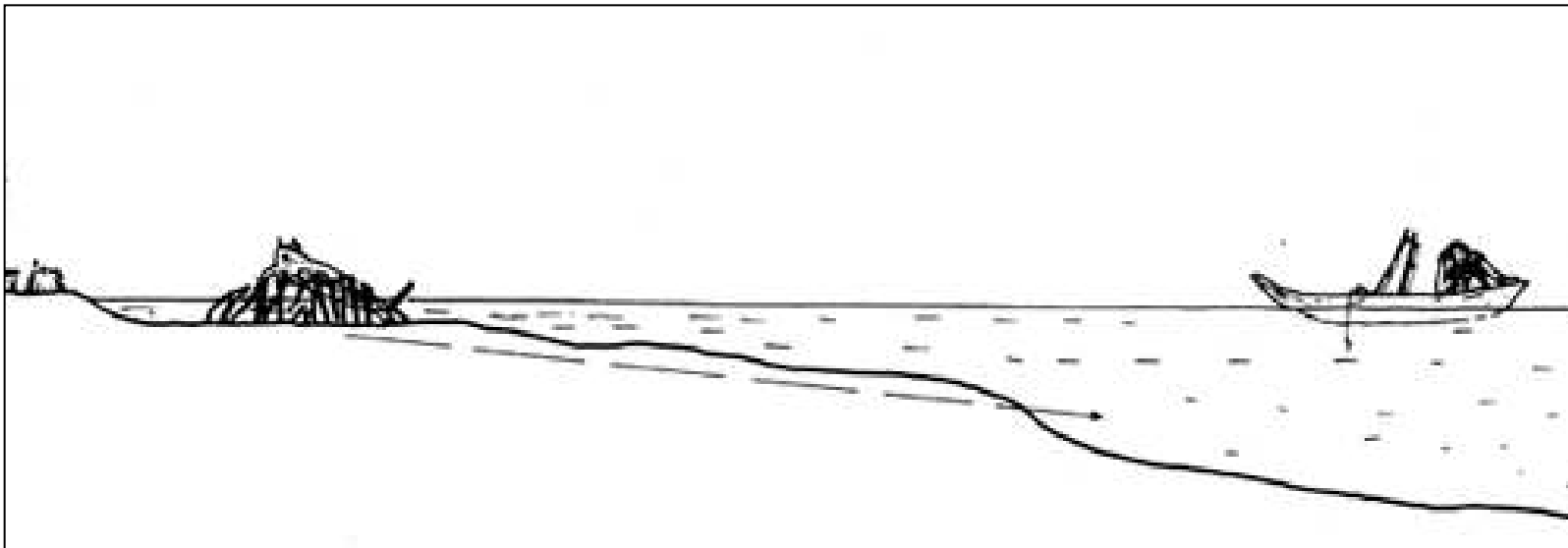
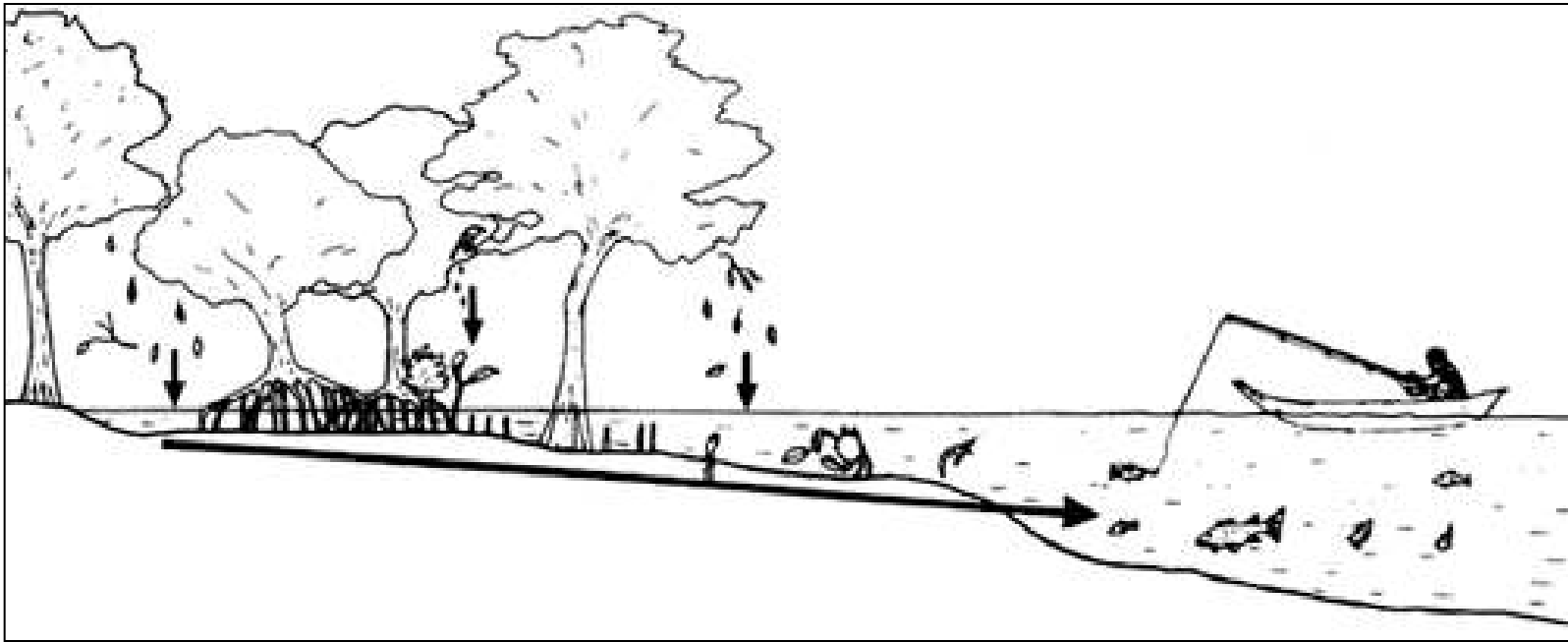
A typical simple mangrove food web.
